ROAD MAP TO SUCCESS



MODULE 1

Stairway to Success

This module welcomes the learners to the world of magic and success. They analyse the case of Walt Disney and climb 7 steps to know what the pinnacle of success is like.

Learning Outcome -
Learners comprehend the 7 basic qualities of a leader including growth mindset, communication, persuasion and collaboration, and apply them in and out of the class as a stepping stone to becoming sensible and innovative leaders.

MODULE 2

The Art of Communicating and Problem Solving

This module inspires the learners to learn and analyse a real-life case about global warming and use their skills to create an action plan and then perform a speech in the end.


Learning Outcome -
Learners interpret and analyse a case on global warming and apply their skills to provide a solution for the issue, following which they prepare and perform a speech on the topic.

MODULE 3

Oratory Skills

This module introduces the learners to the nuances and techniques of public speaking.

Learning Outcome -
Learners familiarise and practice 6 types of speeches including motivational, persuasive, informative, demonstrative, entertaining and JAM speeches.

4

Say It

This module helps learners develop knowledge, skills, and judgement around human communication that facilitate their ability to work collaboratively with others.

Learning Outcome -

Learners attain impeccable communication skills that include communication competencies such as social filter, understanding small group processes etc.

MODULE

5

Sportsmen and Leadership

In all stages of life, the attitude and overall culture of a team is a direct reflection of its leadership. The primary goals of this module are to help current and aspiring leaders gain a better understanding of different leadership approaches that have been considered effective in the sports realm.

Learning Outcome -

Learners understand and practice leadership skills developed in sports including spontaneous decision-making, self-discipline, accountability and integrity.

MODULE

6

Written Word

The aim of this module is to develop writing skills in a medley of modes and for a variety of audiences through sessions centred on craft, process, and aesthetic traditions in all of the genres we teach.

Learning Outcome -

Learners produce a portfolio of original writings with clarity and purpose by understanding innovative techniques in creative writing.





MODULE
7

Reasoning Skills

This module aims at training the learners to develop debate and discussion skills for classroom interaction as well as for real-life encounters. The learners will form a clear perspective on conducting civil social discussions with sound reasoning.

Learning Outcome -
Learners demonstrate the knowledge of expressing their opinions, agreeing or disagreeing with others' perspectives and reasoning for the same by applying the acquired debating.

MODULE
8

Art of Storytelling

This module will encourage learners to tap into their potential as narrators and creators of stories, and become effective communicators who master a variety of tools for storytelling.


Learning Outcome -
Learners present a story before an audience by comprehending the rationale for the telling of stories, outlining a story and applying the principles, structures and elements of storytelling.

MODULE
9

Thinking Out of the Box

Higher-order thinking skills go beyond basic observation of facts and memorization. They are what we are talking about when we want our students to be evaluative, creative and innovative. It distinguishes thinking skills from low-order developments such as those attained by rote memorization.

Learning Outcome -
Learners draw upon prior knowledge, skills, creativity, and experience when a problem is provided.





MODULE
10

Presentation Skills

Delivering an effective presentation can be the differentiator that provides the competitive edge for new-age leaders. This module attempts to demystify the stress and nerves surrounding presentations of various forms including PPT presentations, Vlogging, Pitching ideas etc.

Learning Outcome -

This module provides a structured methodology for learners to prepare and deliver effective, high-impact presentations that meet the objectives and bring results.

MODULE
11

Communication

This module focuses on advanced means of articulation to aid the learners to express themselves through contemporary means of communication.

Learning Outcome -

Learners apply their articulatory skills to produce original mass communication media viz podcasts, TED talks etc.

12

Habits of Mind

The Habits of Mind are an identified set of 16 problem-solving, life-related skills, necessary to effectively operate in society. Considered fundamental to liberal education, Habits of Mind foster each student's development as one who seeks to know the truth and is preparing for a lifelong pursuit of knowledge.

Learning Outcome -

Learners think deliberately and express themselves in a coherent and persuasive manner. Habits of Mind promote strategic reasoning, insightfulness, perseverance, creativity and craftsmanship in the learners.

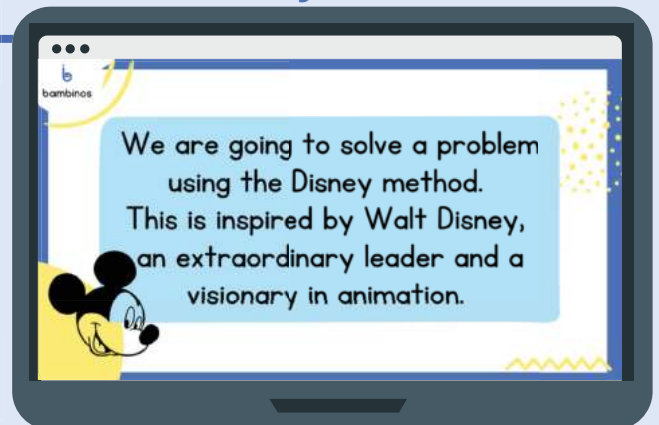

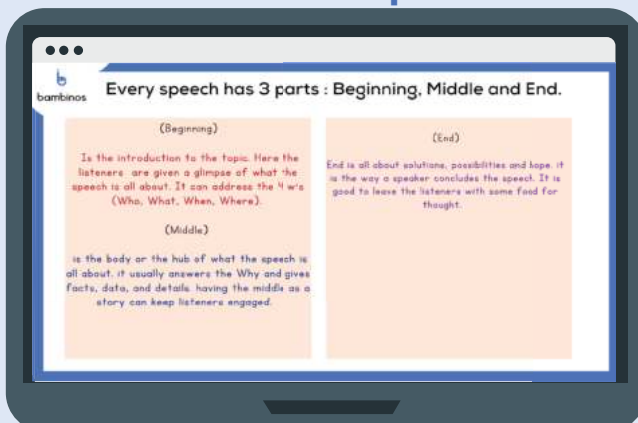
