MODULE
1

Say It

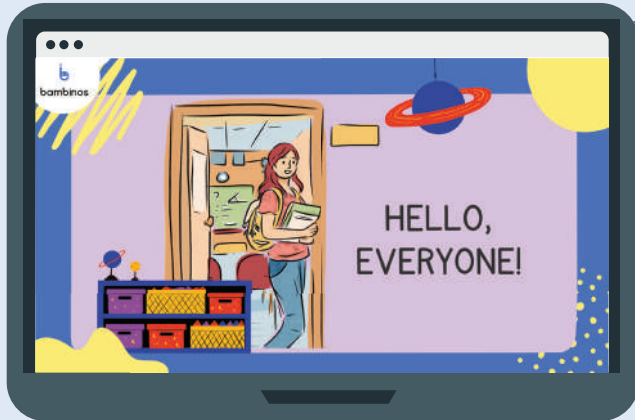
This module will focus on all the different aspects of oral communication. They will challenge themselves with debating, group discussion, impromptu speeches, and other forms of formal speeches.

Students will practice and learn to use different methodologies for different occasions and topics.**

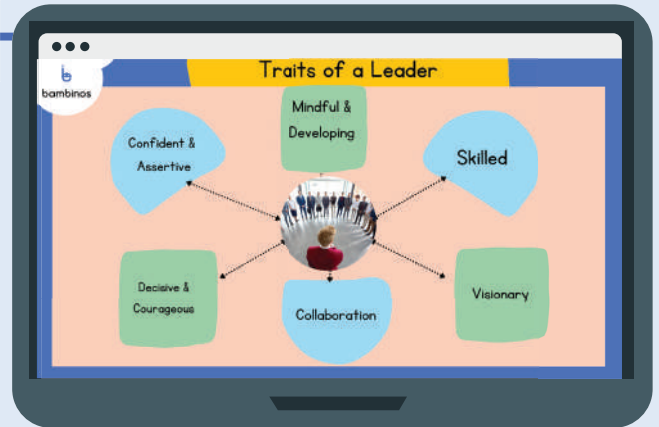

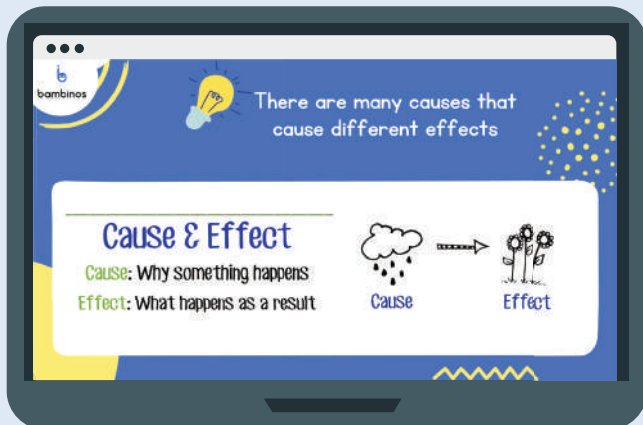

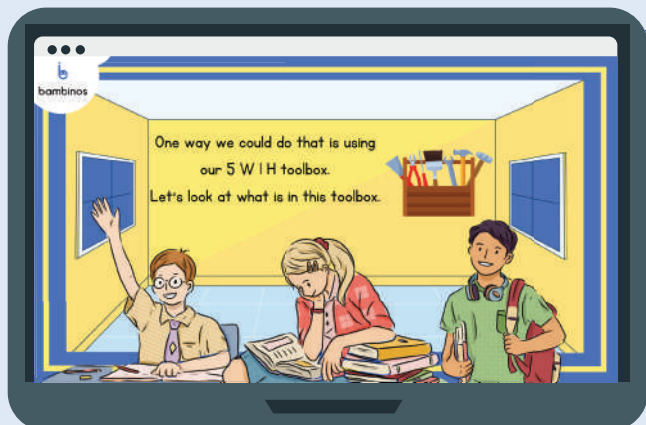
Introduction to Problem Solving by Case Study Methodology



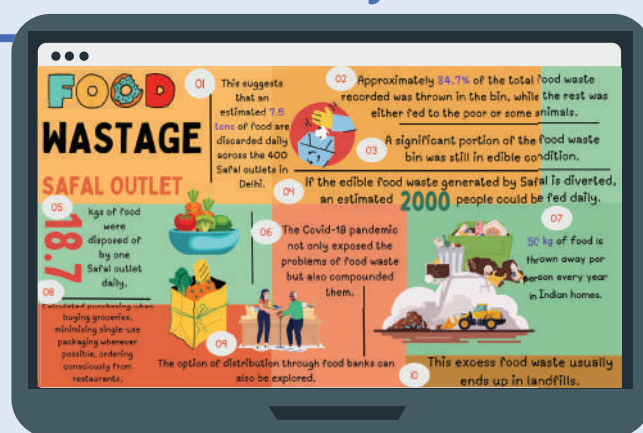

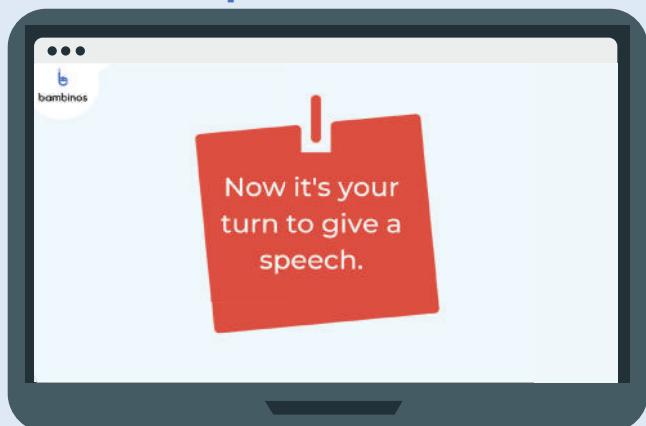
Problem Solving via 5 W I H Toolbox
